The Pacific Meteorological Council (PMC) serves as a specialised subsidiary body of the SPREP Meeting, responsible for facilitating and coordinating the scientific and technical program and activities of the Regional Hydrological and Meteorological Services. The 6th Pacific Meteorological Council meeting will encompass a comprehensive examination of strategic matters, both on a national and regional scale.

The inaugural Development Partners and Donors Engagement Meeting aims to facilitate crucial discussions between donors and the Pacific Meteorological Council (PMC) regarding enhancing weather, climate, ocean, water, and other essential development services. The primary objective of this meeting is to strengthen the resilience and prosperity of Pacific communities while simultaneously advancing economic, social, and environmental development at the national and local levels. A key focus will be placed on implementing the Weather-Ready Pacific Programme of Investment, which received endorsement from Pacific Leaders during the 51st Pacific Leaders Meeting in 2021.

The forthcoming 3rd Pacific Ministerial Meeting on Meteorology (PMMM-3), scheduled for the 18th August 2023, will serve as a platform for discussing strategic matters of significance in the region. Key topics of focus will include providing updates on the progress made in implementing the Nuku'alofa Ministerial Declaration, which pertains to sustainable weather and climate services for a resilient Pacific, as well as the Honiara Ministerial Statement on sustainable weather, climate, oceans, and water for a resilient Pacific. Special attention will be given to the Weather-Ready Pacific Programme of Investment. Emphasis will be placed on developing services to ensure the safety and well-being of Pacific communities.

SPREP and the Pacific Meteorological Council are committed to common principles and goals, including social inclusion and gender equality.
