**SUBJECT:** Invitation to attend the 17<sup>th</sup> Conference of the Contracting Parties to the Noumea Convention as Observers

Dear Focal Points,

The 17<sup>th</sup> Conference of the Contracting Parties to the Noumea Convention (Noumea COP17) will convene on 31 August 2023 at the Taumeasina Island Resort in Samoa. This will follow the 12<sup>th</sup> Conference of the Contracting Parties to the Waigani Convention on 1 September 2023.

As non-Parties to the Noumea Convention, the Secretariat invites a representative from your respective countries to attend the Noumea COP17 Conference as Observers. Rules 6, 7 and 8 of the Rules of Procedure of the Noumea Convention makes provision for the Secretariat to invite non-Parties to attend as Observers.

Observers invited to the Conference shall be permitted to speak on any matter only after the Contracting Parties have spoken. In addition, Observers at the invitation of the Chairperson and with the consent of the Conference may participate without vote in the deliberations of the Conference.
