Purpose

1. To explain the procedure for the conduct of the Meeting and to elect officers.

Background

2. The Rules of Procedure of the Noumea Convention apply. Copies may be obtained from <http://www.sprep.org/legal/regional.htm>.
3. Rule 20 of the Rules of Procedures states that at the commencement of the first session of each ordinary meeting, a Chairperson and a Vice-Chairperson are to be elected from among the representatives of the Contracting Parties by a simple majority vote. There are 12 Parties to the Convention. Australia, Cook Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, Fiji, France, Marshall Islands, Nauru, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea, Samoa, Solomon Islands, United States of America.
