## Agenda Item 9.1: Report on Members' Contributions

## Purpose

1. To report to the Meeting on Members' Contributions

## Background

2. Financial Regulation 14 requires the Director General to submit to each SPREP Meeting a report on the receipt of Members' contributions. This report provides an update on the status of Members' contributions as at $31^{\text {st }}$ December 2016 as well as a brief update on the status of membership contributions to date (as at the time of the meeting).

## Members' Contributions received in 2016 and 2017

3. The audited Financial Statements as at $31^{\text {st }}$ December 2016 noted total contributions received from Members of US\$1,005,105 which is a decrease of US\$422,349 compared to contributions received in 2015 of US\$1,427,454.
4. As circulated, you will find attached for Members' information the latest updated statement of contributions as at $30^{\text {th }}$ June 2017 (see table below). As the table indicates, the total balance that was outstanding on contributions from members at 31 December 2016 was USD $\$ 288,612$. The table also shows the amounts due from respective Members as at $30^{\text {th }}$ June 2017 comprising of unpaid amounts from prior years and amounts outstanding to date for the current year.
5. Contributions due for 2017, amount to $\$ 1,069,771$, and voluntary contributions is $\$ 53,489$. As at $30^{\text {th }}$ June 2017, the Secretariat had received only US\$790,179 of the 2017 contributions, which in combination with prior years' outstanding contributions leaves an outstanding balance on unpaid contributions from members of US\$621,689 (refer to Annex 1).

## Outstanding Contributions

6. Other than Members with small adjusting balances, the following are Member countries with outstanding contributions as at 30 June 2017 for both 2017 and prior years' contributions:
