SPREP, in partnership with the United Nation Environment Program will be convening Workshop on Green Economy & Steps Taken to Implement SDG's October 4-5, in Nadi, Fiji.

The main objectives of this meeting will be to:

- a) Share experiences on the implementation of Green Economy/Green Growth initiatives by the Countries and Establish partnership platform amongst countries and development partners on implementation of green economy/growth activities.
- b) Raise awareness on Roadmap to implement SDGs and share national activities on implementation of SDGs.
- c) Highlight key issues, challenges and opportunities and Explore tools and initiatives that can help Pacific implementation.
- d) Identify potential project concepts

SPREP will organise return economy airfares, as well as a daily subsistence allowance to cover accommodation and meal costs for one representative of your country.

Samoa will be requested to nominate two representatives since there will be two presentations delivered by them. Fiji will be nominating four representatives since they are hosting and cost of their engagement is minimal. The rest of the selected countries are to nominate one representative.
