

- Premier global event on parks and protected areas held every ten years
- Sets the global agenda, direction and trends in contemporary protected area management for the following decade
- 2003: Durban, South Africa, produced the Durban Action Plan adopted by the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD)
- Hosts: IUCN, Parks Australia, NSW National Parks & Wildlife Service

### Park: Biodiversity conservation

Strengthen policy and action commitments for the expansion, connectivity and better management of parks and protected areas to cover areas all important for biodiversity and ecosystem services.

### People: Sustainable development

Foster the equitable governance of parks and protected areas to empower communities (including Indigenous communities) to become involved and to benefit.

### Planet: Nature based solutions

Explore and promote parks and protected areas as natural solutions to global challenges such as climate change, food and water security, health and green economy.


