Report on Members' Contributions

Purpose of Paper

1. To report to the Meeting on Members' Contributions.

Background

2. Financial Regulation 14 requires the Director General to submit to each SPREP Meeting a report on the receipt of Members' contributions. This report provides an update on the status of Members' contributions as at 31st December 2018 as audited, as well as a brief update on the status of membership contributions at the time of drafting this report (31 May 2019). A further update will be provided at the Meeting.

Update

- 3. The audited Financial Statements as at 31st December 2018 noted total contributions received from Members of US\$1,172,741, a decrease of US\$177,321 from 2017 contributions received of US\$1,350,062. The decrease is attributed to the receipt in 2017 of outstanding contributions. Overall, collection of members' annual contributions has improved over the last 2 years.
- 4. The latest updated statement of contributions as at 31st May 2019 is attached as Annex 1. The table shows that the total balance of outstanding contributions from members at 31 December 2018 was USD\$60,117. This is a significant improvement on prior years (2016-\$288,612; 2017-\$82,101).
- 5. The table also shows the amounts expected from Members as at 31st May 2019 comprising unpaid amounts from prior years and amounts outstanding to date for the current year. These total \$1,156,632. As at 31st May 2019, the Secretariat had received US\$606,530 or 52% of the 2019 contributions, which in combination with prior years' outstanding contributions leaves an outstanding balance on unpaid contributions from members of US\$610,219.

6. Other than Members with small adjusting balances, the following table summarises Member countries with outstanding contributions as at 31st May 2019 for both 2019 and prior years' contributions:
