2. Entry Requirements & Passport

Visitors to Samoa can apply for a 90-day Visitor Permit on arrival using the arrival card. Travellers must have:

- a passport valid for at least 6 months beyond the intended stay
- confirmed onward tickets (Return Ticket)
- visas for the next country of destination (if required)
- sufficient funds to support themselves (while in Samoa)
- confirmed residential contact address

3. Airport Transport Arrangements

Delegates are advised to arrange their own airport transfer. Public transport is available by taxi or shuttle service if arranged in advance with your accommodation provider.

4. Communication and Foreign Exchange

Outside the Arrivals area at Faleolo International Airport, there are two booths of Samoa's main mobile service providers: Digicel and Vodafone. Both offer SIM and data services, and you are encouraged to purchase these at the airport for convenience.

There is a Bank of South Pacific and Western Union - Number 1 Currency counter inside the arrivals terminal for foreign exchange as well as outside the terminal including ANZ Bank and various ATM's.

Taumeasina Island Resort also has a Bank of South Pacific ATM located in the main lobby area.

5. Currency

Samoa currency is Tala (SAT). All major currencies are generally accepted in main banks and foreign exchange counters.

The current exchange rate is approximately USD 1 \approx SAT 2.63, subject to fluctuation. Credit/debit cards are accepted by all major hotels, big restaurants, and some super-markets.

6. Registration

There will be a registration table located in the glass area before entering the Main Conference Venue. Delegates will receive identification badges at the time of registration; please wear these badges throughout the duration of the meeting/s for security and catering purposes.

14. Electricity voltage and adaptor

For Samoa the associated plug type is I, which is the plug that has three flat pins in a triangular pattern. Samoa operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz. See below.

Samoa's climate and weather is warm and humid throughout the year. The temperature in September is usually between 24 to 30 degrees Celsius.
