2. Brief Description (What the side event is about)

The Emma Luke Earth Observation (EO) Centre at SPREP will serve as a regional hub for environmental monitoring and geospatial innovation, offering a suite of services to support evidence-based policymaking and sustainable development. The Centre is strategically positioned within SPREP to complement existing regional initiatives, bridge data gaps, and foster collaboration between governments, academia, civil society, and international partners.

The Centre is named in honour of Emma Luke, a passionate advocate for environmental conservation and geospatial innovation in the Pacific.
