Agenda item 6.3: Report on Membership Contribution

Purpose:

1. To report to the Meeting on Members' contributions.

Background:

- 2. Financial Regulation 14 requires the Director General to submit to each SPREP Meeting a report on the receipt of Members' contributions.
- 3. This report provides an update on the status of Members' contributions as at 31 December 2024, as well as a brief update on the latest status of membership contributions at the time of drafting this report (as at 30 April 2025). A further update will be provided at the Meeting.

Update:

- 4. The Audited Financial Statements as at 31 December 2024 noted total contributions income from Members of USD\$1,271,981, which is a slight increase of US\$81,736 from 2023 contributions of USD\$1,190,245. The overall nett balance (cash basis) outstanding from members as at 31 December 2024 was USD\$233,440 (refer Att.1).
- 5. The table in Att.2 provides the latest updated statement of contributions as at 30 April 2025 which shows the amounts expected from Members for current year contributions, totals USD\$1,281,981. As at 30 April 2025, the Secretariat had received USD\$593,611 or 39% of the 2025 contributions, which in combination with prior years' outstanding contributions leaves an outstanding nett balance on unpaid contributions from members of USD\$921,810 (refer Att.2).

 - 1) consider the report and address the issue of outstanding member contributions;
 - 2) address the issue of outstanding member contributions; and
 - 3) **commit** itself collectively and individually to paying current and outstanding contributions in full in 2025.
