SUBJECT: UNFCCC COP24 Information and Briefing Papers for the Pacific Island Countries Delegations

Dear COP24 Pacific delegation focal points,

In line with the UNFCCC COP24 One-CROP Plus Engagement Plan, the One-CROP Plus Team have updated technical briefing papers on negotiation threads as identified by the Pacific as priorities for the upcoming UNFCCC negotiations.

The purpose of the technical briefings and communication products have been developed with input from Pacific delegates who have participated in relevant meetings and more recently the preparatory meeting held in Fiji. To that end, a suite of relevant technical briefings, communications products and information is attached as agreed to in the preparatory meeting.

As you are aware, the One CROP agencies have been working together under the Pacific Partnership with COP23 Presidency and with support from the Government of New Zealand to setup, organise and manage the Pacific and Koronivia Pavilion for COP24. The Pavilion will host daily side events linked to the vision of the COP23 Presidency and themes of the Pavilion are: Koronivia Joint Work on Agriculture (KJWA); Ocean Pathway Partnership; and the Talanoa Dialogue. The Pacific, Agriculture and Oceans will feature strongly in the Pavilion. It will open from 2 to 14 December and is located at the International Conference Centre (MCK) on the ground floor of Pavilion E next to the EU (see Map of the venue).
