With the establishment of the UN Sustainable Development Goals in 2015, the Human Development Forum has expanded its publishing operations with the creation of a series of volumes entitled "A Better World", each dedicated to one or more of the 17 SDGs.

The attached is the fourth volume which is dedicated to Goal 15: Life on Land, and particularly Goal 15.3, which aims to achieve Land Degradation Neutrality globally by 2030. This can be kept in your library and used as a reference material on SDG 15.
