**Dr. Martin Sharp**, an Australian national, has been appointed to the position of Project Manager, GCCA+ Intra ACP Pacific Adaptation to Climate Change and Resilience (PACRES) Project within the Climate Change Resilience (CCR) Programme. Martin holds a PhD from the Australia National University (ANU) and a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) from the University of New South Wales, Australia. He brings with him extensive project management experience in Australia and across the Pacific including leading roles in the Pacific Climate Change Sciences Programme (PCCSP), Pacific Adaptation Strategy Assistance Programme (PASAP) and the Pacific-Australia Climate Change Science and
