Please find attached the invitation from the Chairperson of the Pacific Resilience Partnership Task Force, Mr. Engel Raygadas, to the inaugural Pacific Resilience Meeting (PRM) which is confirmed to be held at the University of the South Pacific in Suva, Fiji from 1 to 3 of May 2019. It will be held in collaboration with the European Commission's Directorate-General for International Cooperation and Development (DG DEVCO) Global Climate Change Plus flagship initiative (GCCA+) meeting following the third Climate Action Pacific Partnership Conference (CAPPIII).

The PRM will bring together the Pacific Climate Change Roundtable, the Pacific Platform for Disaster Risk Management, the low carbon development community of practice, the Pacific Humanitarian Partnership and the European Union GCCA+.

Themed *Youth Futures in a Resilient Pacific*, the PRM is a multi-sectoral, multi-stakeholder meeting that will take stock of progress and review and strengthen operational processes relating to the implementation of the three goals of the Framework for Resilient Development in the Pacific (FRDP).
