



# Record of the Pacific Climate Change Centre Steering Committee Teleconference Meeting

### (31 August 2018)

- 1. The Pacific Climate Change Centre Steering Committee teleconference meeting was attended by the Cook Islands, French Polynesia, New Zealand, JICA, and the SPREP Secretariat. Apologies were received for Australia, New Caledonia, Niue, Tokelau, the United Kingdom and the Pacific Community. (Refer to Annex 1)
- **2.** The Secretariat provided a brief overview of the revised draft PCCC Strategy and Business Plan which had incorporated many of the suggestions received to date from Steering Committee members.
- 3. The new governance arrangements of the PCCC Advisory Board was discussed where it was noted that it now includes the Chair of the Pacific Resilience Partnership Taskforce; the Chair of the Pacific Meteorological Council; as well as three representatives from each sub-region of Melanesia, Micronesia and Polynesia on an annually rotating basis; and the Government of Samoa as host country of SPREP and the PCCC. Other members include JICA; a development partner; and up to two research institutions.
- **4.** The Steering Committee agreed:
  - to the revised composition of the Advisory Board (as outlined in the revised draft);
  - to provide any further comments to the Secretariat on the draft by Monday 4 September; and
  - to progress the draft PCCC Strategy and Business Plan to the Executive Board for endorsement.
