SUBJECT: SAVE THE DATE: HIGH LEVEL SEGMENT AT THE 10TH PACIFIC ISLANDS CONFERENCE ON NATURE CONSERVATION AND PROTECTED AREAS, 24TH APRIL 2020, NEW CALEDONIA

Dear Honorable Ministers.

We are pleased to inform you that SPREP in partnership with the Pacific Islands Roundtable for Nature Conservation (PIRT) and the Government of New Caledonia will be hosting the 10th Pacific Islands Conference on Nature Conservation and Protected Areas at the Tjibaou Cultural Center Noumea, New Caledonia from the 19 - 24 April, 2020.

The Government of New Caledonia will be hosting a High-level Segment for Ministers and Heads-of-organisations on the 24th April, 2020 as a key component of the Conference. I kindly request that you save this date in your calendar.
