We are pleased to inform you that the SWAP (*Committing to Sustainable Waste Actions in the Pacific*) project is releasing an Expression of Interest to assist Pacific islands countries and territories in managing used oil problems generated in the region. This EOI aims to establish a register of companies that may have technology available to assist PICs to set up a System of Processing/Recovery of used oils adapted to each local specificity.

The creation and maintenance of this register will enable member countries and territories to access up-to-date information on companies able to provide technological support for the treatment/recovery of waste oils.
