
This meeting is critical in setting the collective PSIDS priorities in the lead up to the UNFCCC Subsidiary Bodies sessions in June and COP28 in December 2023.

The meeting will enable PSIDS delegations to reflect on the outcomes of COP27 and what it means for the Pacific region in dealing with the impacts of climate change. It will also provide an opportunity to reflect on lessons learnt from the engagement of PSIDS Political Climate Change Champions and negotiators at COP27.
