Agenda item 4: Consideration and approval of the revised 2024-2025 Business Plan for the Pacific Regional Centre for the Joint Implementation of the Basel and Waigani Conventions

Purpose of paper

1. To present the revised 2024-2025 Business Plan for the Pacific Regional Centre for consideration and approval by the Meeting.

Background

- 2. Under Article VII.2 of the revised Memorandum of Understanding establishing the PRC, 2014, between the Secretariat of the Basel Convention and SPREP on behalf of its Members, the Steering Committee of the PRC is responsible for reviewing and approving a Business Plan developed by the Centre and overseeing its implementation.
- 3. The 2024-2025 Business Plan was developed and presented to the Twelfth Meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Waigani Convention (COP-12) for consideration and approval. However, Parties could not agree on approving the business plan.
- 4. Parties directed the Secretariat to revise the 2024-2025 Business Plan and present it for reconsideration at an extraordinary meeting on 13 October 2023. The revised draft Business Plan for 2024-2025 is presented in WC COP EO1_Agenda 3_Annex 1_Revised 2024-2025 Business Plan of the PRC. This should be read in conjunction with WC COP EO1_Agenda 3_Annex 2_Detailed Core budget.
- 5. The Business Plan incorporates the work programme and budget of the Waigani Convention and Centre to avoid duplication of effort. It further follows the format of the budget as agreed to in WC COP 1 in 2002 under the convention's Approved Financial Rules.
- 6. The revised 2024-2025 Business Plan has a total budget of USD 4,127,900 consisting of a Core Budget of USD 117,900 and a Programmatic Budget of USD 4,010,00. The Core Budget will be funded by Party contributions and existing surplus funds of the Convention which stand at USD 149,966 as reported at COP-12.
- 7. A note has been prepared by the Secretariat, at the request of Parties at COP-12, to provide details of the Core Budget and explanations on expenditure and sources of funds. The Note from the Secretariat is attached as WC COP EO1_Agenda 4_Annex 3_Note from Secretariat
