- 2. Regional Climate Centre Network Management Committee Meeting, 8 9 December

These meetings form part of the Pacific RCC-N's ongoing efforts to strengthen regional climate service capabilities under the framework of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) Regional Association V (Southwest Pacific). The RCC-N operates as a network of specialized nodes that collaboratively deliver climate monitoring, forecasting, and capacity development services in support of National Meteorological and Hydrological Services (NMHSs) across the Pacific region.

The upcoming meetings build upon the outcomes of the previous RCC-N Management Committee Meetings and are critical in finalising preparations for the RCC-N designation application due in March 2026.

These meetings are being organized with financial support from the 11th European Development Fund (EDF) Intra-ACP Climate Services and Related Applications (ClimSA) Project.

## **Objectives**

The core objectives of the meetings are to:

- Review the status of the Pacific RCC-N designation process and align outstanding components such as the operational plan, website, methodology for product generation, monitoring and evaluation system, user group establishment, and research and development initiatives.
- Discuss the implementation of WMO Node recommendations and outline clear action plans.
- Review progress from previous meetings and revise the RCC-N Terms of Reference, where applicable.
- Endorse key operational and governance matters to enhance coordination; and
- Pathway established for submission of designation by March 2026.

Your participation and input will be invaluable to ensure cohesive, strategic, and timely progress toward our shared goals for the Pacific RCC-N. The agenda and other details will be shared in due course.
