The Secretariat is pleased to inform Pacific Members of the financial support available for one delegate per PSIDS country to attend the UNFCCC COP30 in Belém, Brazil, from 10-21 November 2025.

This support, generously provided by the Governments of Australia and New Zealand, includes the delegate's direct return economy airfare to Belém and a daily subsistence allowance (DSA) for the duration of COP30. Please note that this support does not cover travel insurance, visa arrangements, or any additional travel costs, including port entry requirements and post-ticket issuance changes. These costs are the responsibility of the nominating country.

Focal points are invited to submit nominations no later than the close of business on 11 September 2025. Please complete the attached nomination form and email it to Ms. Tagaloa Cooper, Director of the Climate Change Resilience Programme, at tagaloac@sprep.org, and copied to foinijanceyf@sprep.org and teuilajanef@sprep.org. The nomination form must include a copy of the delegates passport biodata to facilitate travel arrangements. Once submitted, changes to nominations cannot be accommodated due to time constraints and alignment with the SPREP travel policy.
