Response:

The tenders are a competitive tender with applications assessed on value for money. The proposal will be assessed against the criteria outlined in the terms of reference.

For the mid-term evaluation, it requires someone locally to support document collections and meeting organizations, does SPREP will provide these support?

Response:

Whilst SPREP will provide some support to the review team in terms of documentation and meetings, the tender stipulates the inclusion of a local based consultant as part of the review team. It is the intention the local based consultant will be the point person for the review team in collecting documentation, organising meetings, and consulting with stakeholders in-country.
