Question 1:

Could you advise on the budget ceiling or financial proposal for this engagement?

Response:

Between € 75,000 - € 80,000

Question 2:

What is the duration of the Project and when is the estimated start date? We need this information to project our Financial Proposal.

Response:

The project around Karama will begin as soon as a contract is signed with the successful bidder and to be completed by 30 June 2022.

Question 3:

Will there be any support from your PNG Counterpart, the CCDA in terms of provision of logistical support and the host community such as provision of a dedicated accommodation /lodging venue at the Project site?

Response:

CCDA is SPREP's implementing partner for the PACRES project in Papua New Guinea. SPREP also has a project officer based in CCDA who can provide assistance and advice to the project team. However, the successful bidder for the project around Karama will need to be self-sufficient and identify any requirements for travel to and from and local accommodation at the project site. This must be identified and costed in the financial proposal as per paragraph 5 of the terms of reference which indicated the financial proposal
